He then toured individual classrooms for more storytelling, attended a reception and book signing in the evening, returned for more visits on Friday and took part in a sleigh ride with staff on Saturday.

But thanks to the persistence of Mrs. Livingston and her students over the years, and mostly thanks to their very original requests, Mr. Munsch made his first visit in 2002.
