NCDSB Adopts "You Are the Light of the World" As the New Board Theme

Northeastern Catholic District School Board, January 11th, 2008: January 15th marks the official launch of our new Board Theme ~ "You are the light of the world." Liturgical celebrations will be held in all of our Catholic schools throughout the Districts of Cochrane and Temiskaming as well as the Board office.

Last year the Board's Faith Committee agreed that having a Board-wide faith theme would be a good way to reach our many stakeholders in a positive and affirming manner. Our Catholic schools cover a wide geographical area from Kapuskasing to Cobalt and include many beautiful communities, each with their own history and traditions. The Faith unique Committee, comprised of stakeholders such as school administrators, students, teachers, support staff, parents, trustees and clergy, felt that a Board theme would help unify our School Board. It will also remind all of us who work, study, or support our schools that our faith is at the root of who we are as a community of schools.

The selection of the Board theme came after a comprehensive consultation with our students, staff, parents, parishes, community members, trustees and administration staff. Over 60% of those who provided feedback chose "You are the light of the world" as the theme that best represents our Catholic school communities.
