# **CONTROL OF PEDICULOSIS**

POLICY #: G-5 AUTHORITY: 99-324/12-49

### **POLICY STATEMENT**

The Northeastern Catholic District School Board endorses the guidelines outlined below which have been provided by local Health Units for pediculosis (the presence of head lice or their eggs).

### **POLICY REGULATIONS**

#### 1. Role of the Teacher:

- 1.1 To be aware of the symptoms which might indicate the presence of pediculosis;
- 1.2 To identify students with suspected infestations;
- 1.3 To ensure that the principal and parents are notified of suspected infestations;
- 1.4 To actively promote preventative practices to avoid further infestation in the classroom and the school.

### 2. Role of the Principal:

- 2.1 To ensure that the parents are notified of the identified infestation and the recommended treatment:
- 2.2 To exclude from school those who have an identified infestation;
- 2.3 To ensure that those identified are treated to prevent re-infestation;
- 2.4 To send home a general letter to all parents after the discovery of pediculosis within the school outlining measures of identification and treatment.

### 3. Suggested Role of the Parent:

- 3.1 To be aware of the symptoms which might indicate an infestation;
- 3.2 To identify suspected infestations, where possible;
- 3.3 To ensure that proper and full treatment occurs;
- 3.4 To indicate to the principal that proper and full treatment has occurred.
