Nancy Cole also talked about the CNIB SCORE Summer Program, a unique summer experience for 16 to 18 year olds with vision loss from across Canada who are in their final two years of secondary school. Bill Russell mentioned that the Poverty Action Coalition is establishing a pilot project. More information will be available in February. He added that young students from various schools are visiting the Lord's Kitchen on a more regular basis.

The Timmins Transition Committee has launched an innovative project thanks to a grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation. The three-year grant will support the development and implementation of a community-wide framework for service delivery. Children and young people with special needs and their families will be provided with seamless access to services and support in Timmins and area.

Kay Gaffney will provide some information at the next meeting on a new initiative of the Child and Family Services of Timmins.
