- 1. Let your actions be guided by the idea that Jesus said, "Let he who is without sin, cast the first stone."
 - It's easy to criticize others but no one is perfect.
 - If God doesn't judge us, how can WE judge others.
- 2. The first step to forgiveness is to take responsibility for your actions.
 - We usually know when we've done something wrong.
 - Saying sorry can be tough but if you're wrong, it's the right thing to do.
- 3. If you want to be forgiven, you need to make sure you forgive other people.
 - We know that God will always forgive us when we do something wrong.
 - If someone is really trying to make things better, we should try and move on from our anger and forgive them the way God forgives us.
- 4. Live your life in a way that makes others know you are a follower of Christ.
 - Jesus forgave others even when he was on the cross.
