School Website & Information Sharing with Parents

Mrs. Rogers requested an update on the school website. Mr. Berthier explained that unfortunately we do not control the website. However we do post our monthly calendar, newsletter and important information for parents & students.

Mr. Berthier stated that he will be attending a Principal's meeting and would share School Council's request to have more control over the website. He will follow-up on his previous request for clerical access to set up a revolving calendar of school events and activities.

The following suggestions were made to work on a school website:

Mr. Berthier offered to write a letter on behalf of School Council to the Board with our requests. School Council will sign the letter. Mr. Berthier will also speak with other principals about the website.

Suggestions for Reaching Out Grant

Proposed 2011-2012 School Calendar

Mr. Berthier circulated the proposed calendar and explained to School Council that there is a rotation where each board is responsible for drafting the calendar. This year CSDNE is responsible. The rationale behind their submission was reviewed.

It was suggested that PA Day of June 11th be brought forward to September 26th.

School Improvement Plan (SIP)

Mr. Berthier circulated information on the School Improvement Plan to council members and asked that everyone take a few minutes to read through it.

Clarification was asked regarding the Ontario Common Assessment - Mr. Berthier explained that this is a tool to improve specific reading comprehension strategies. Also questions were asked regarding how can we get parents more involved.

The (SIP) was created to assist teaching staff. Mr. Berthier explained that at one time it used to be "teachers should contact parents" and now it is "teachers must contact parents".

The goal was to draft a parent friendly School Improvement Plan. Mr. Berthier invited school council to review it again and pass on feedback to him.

Mr. Berthier explained that there will be an on-line survey for students, teachers and parents and this will be posted on our Board Website in the near future.
