**Ideas:**

- **Caring Kids Awards** – students who have made a sincere effort in their classrooms and school (clubs, teams etc.) to change the school culture of SHCS this year by helping others, staying positive and demonstrating leadership.
- **Paint the School Blue** - Former Canadian Prime Minister Lester B. Pearson won the Nobel Peace Prize for his work in establishing United Nations Peacekeepers, who wear blue as a symbol of peace as they perform their work around the world.
