# Toques:

### **Poinsettias for Seniors**:

At this time of year, our school would like to bring a little bit of joy to our seniors residing in long term institutions by providing them with a lovely poinsettia plant and a card signed by all our students. Your donation of 25 cents or more will help us to purchase a plant from the Canadian Red Cross.
