Catholic Education Week: Walking in the Light of Christ



Each year, the Catholic community of Ontario engages in a week-long celebration of the unique identity and distinctive contributions of Catholic education during Catholic Education Week. This year's celebration entitled **Catholic Education: Walking in the Light of Christ** is scheduled for the week of May 6 – May 11. The scriptural theme is **'Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path'** taken from the book of Psalms (119:105). In John's gospel, Jesus proclaims, **"I am the Light of the World"** (John 8:12). Our Catholic schools rejoice to walk in that Light, **'a Light which overcomes the darkness with its radiance'** (Matthew 4:16).
