E.C.C.S. staff and students head back to school!

I would like to take this opportunity to **welcome** all students and parents to another exciting and rewarding school year here at English Catholic Central School. A very **special** welcome to our new students and to families new to the Temiskaming Shores area! We are confident that you will have a great year here at E.C.C.S.! If, at any time throughout the school year, you have questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher or call the office at 705-647-4301 to speak with either myself or Mrs. Minnett, our school secretary!

Included in this month's newsletter are a number of information items which pertain to this new academic school year. For a more in depth look at our school's policies and procedures, please be sure to read and sign the school handbook which will be sent home on Friday to every ECCS family!

A reminder that due to busing and supervision requirements, this year's **drop off time is once again 8:35 a.m.** If you need to drop off your child before this time, please contact Timiskaming Child Care (705-672-2100) to access their **Before/After School Program** that is being offered again this year at school. Please also note that this year's lunch hour will be from **11:45 a.m. - 12:45 p.m.**

Once again, Student Agendas are being provided to students in the Junior and Intermediate grades (Grades 4-8). The agenda is an excellent tool for home-school

communication. There is also a Catholic insert with information and activities related to our faith. The handbook and insert will also be sent home for primary students who are once again using a Communication Folder that travels to and from school.

A reminder that due to Safe School Policies, it is necessary that we be extra vigilant about having visitors sign in at the office and have parents remain at the front of the school when picking up their child. Also, a friendly reminder that if you do plan to pick up your child, please provide written notice or **call before 2:00 p.m.** so that the message can be communicated to the classroom or itinerant teacher in time.

Finally, we are also sending home today a number of items: an NCDSB School Year Calendar, a summary of School Bus policies to be signed by both the student and parent, a Board/Student Internet Agreement form for students in Grades 1 to 8, a medical authorization form for any students who require meds to be administered at school. (This includes prescribed medicine as well as Tylenol etc.). We ask that these forms be returned to the school **no later than Thursday, September 13th, 2012.** Please note: an Annual Student Data Update Form has been mailed directly to you for your attention. Please return these to the school so that we may update our records.
