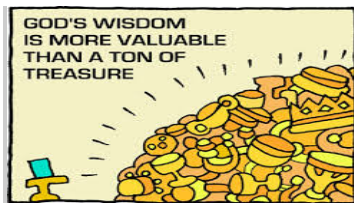

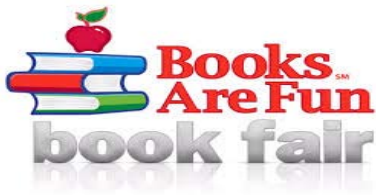
PROGRESS REPORTS
