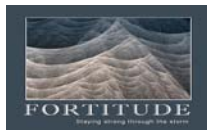

MONTHLY VIRTUE



Our January Virtue is Fortitude which is one of the four cardinal virtues. It is commonly called *courage*; however, it is different from what we often think of. Fortitude is always *reasoned* and *reasonable*. The cardinal virtue of fortitude involves practicing what is good and just when it is difficult or even dangerous. A person of fortitude practices patience when meeting obstacles. They do what is right, even when others criticize them. Fortitude allows us to overcome our fear and remain resilient in the face of obstacles. Prudence and justice are the virtues through which we decide what needs to be done; fortitude gives us the strength to do it. As Catholics we look to Jesus as our model. He always did what was right, even when it cost Him His life. Practicing fortitude is challenging, but it brings deep peace that comes from knowing we have done the right
