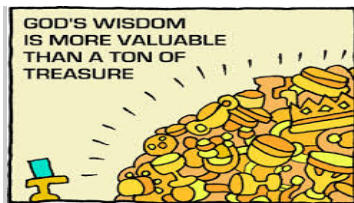

you a tour of their classroom. We hope you will be able to join us on Thursday, **November 14 from 4:30 pm- 7:30 pm.**

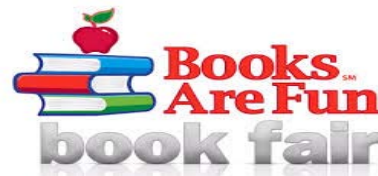


SCHOLASTIC BOOK FAIR
