STUDENT ABSENTEEISM

The attendance verification check is a process which enables schools to verify a student's absence or lateness with the parent or guardian. Parents/guardians are reminded that they must call the school, or leave a message, whenever their child(ren) will be absent or late. Where there are other siblings attending school, a note from the parent is also acceptable. Any students arriving late to school must immediately report to the office upon entering the school. A "late slip" will be issued, and the student must take this slip to his/her teacher. A great deal of learning takes place in the morning as that's when the majority of Language and Math instruction is held, so it is very important that students arrive at school on time.

HEAD LICE

It seems that Spring and Fall are the times of year when these pests like to come to school. We ask that parents check their child(ren)'s head regularly. Information is available at the school and at the Timiskaming Health Unit for those who would like it.
