#### **Bullying is a Relationship Issue**

- Bullying is INTENTIONALLY HURTFUL behavior that happens REPEATEDLY.
- It's about using POWER in an aggressive way to hurt others.
- It can be physical, verbal, relational, exclusionary and done electronically (cyberbullying)

#### **Bullying is NOT:**

- ♦ A conflict between friends
- An argument between people of equal power
- ♦ Accidental
- ♦ A one-time event
