STUDENT LED CONFERENCES



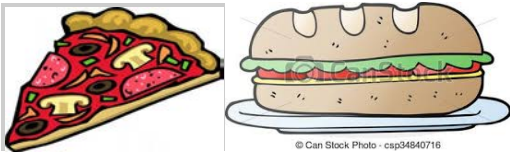
