

How timely that the virtue for this month is FORGIVENESS, not only because we are in the season of Lent but also because it is an important cornerstone of our faith and one that Jesus modeled for us in his life and death. We are reminded that forgiveness is a gift to ourselves as we let go of the burden of resentment when we forgive another person and it's a gift to our children when we teach and model it to them. This month Sacred Heart Catholic School will be exploring the virtue of forgiveness during our Ash Wednesday Service and by celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesday, March 22nd.

Tell Them From Me (TTFM) Survey

our continuing effort to increase school effectiveness, we have implemented an online school survey for students, teachers, and parents – Tell Them From Me (TTFM). The information for parents was mailed to each household earlier this week and must be completed by Friday, March 11th. TTFM allows students, teachers, and parents to give their input into school improvement initiatives in an anonymous way. The parent survey is completed online and will require approximately 30 minutes. It measures such topics as two-way communication, parent support of learning at home, school support of learning and social/emotional development, and parent support of learning at school. The survey also allows parents to give their thoughts and feedback in an open-ended question response. Please take the time to complete it.
