

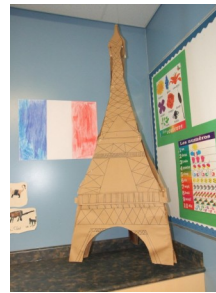

11th at 1:00 pm, there will be a presentation "Gotta Love That French" for all students in the gym.

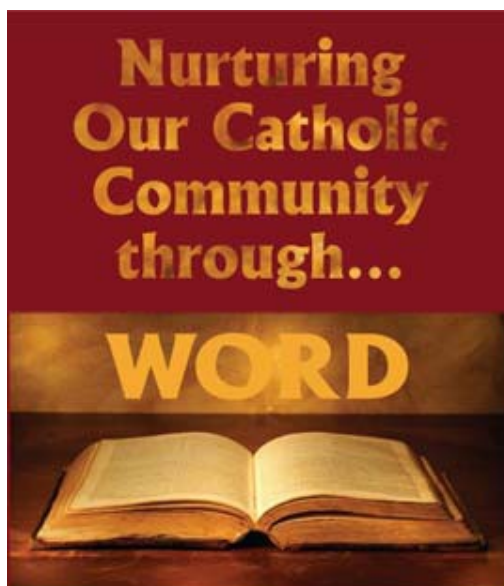
Monday, November 15th is a Professional Activity Day therefore, NO SCHOOL.

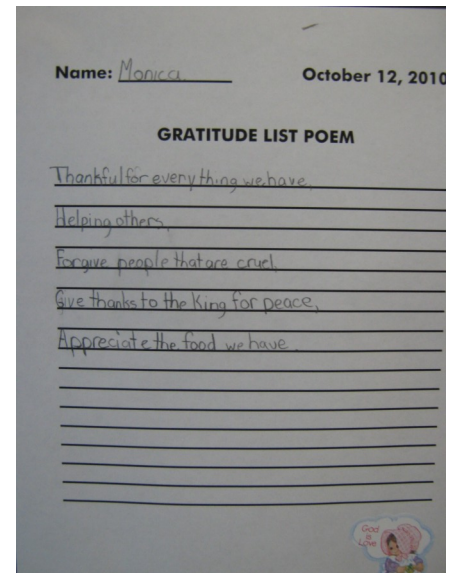
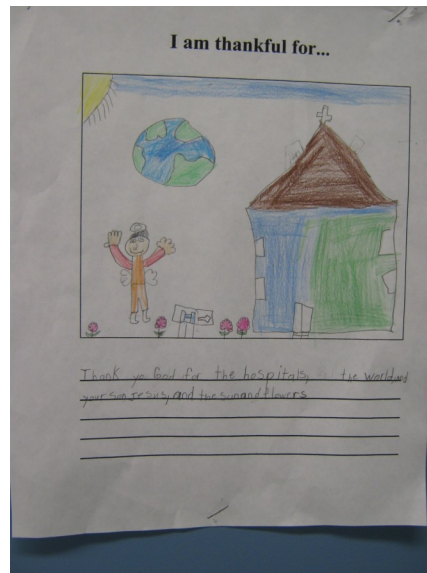
