School Safety Reminder

Parents are welcomed to the school throughout the year, however, for the safety of all children, parents and visitors must use only the front door for entry and must sign in at the office and receive a visitor's badge each and every time you visit the building. Visitors are not entitled to go to the classrooms as this is a disruption to student programming. Since the hallways are busy during pick up times, siblings and parents are asked to meet your child, at the back of the school. Messages and deliveries(keys, lunches, etc.) are handled through the office. Please remember: to most students in the school, you are a stranger.

Student Absences

Student safe arrival at school is paramount. If your child is absent, please call the school to notify. If your child is late for school, they must check into the office before proceeding to class. Children must be signed out at the office by an adult.

Special Arrangements

If there is a change in your child's normal routine at the end of the day, please notify the office by 2:30 p.m. with any special instructions. This will avoid any confusion and ensure that the message is properly relayed. Should your child have an appointment that requires him/her to leave throughout the day, we ask that you send a note to school or call the office, indicating when the child will be picked-up and when they are expected to return.

School Agendas

The students from Grades JK to 3 have received agendas. They serve as a tool for home-school communication. To help alleviate the cost, we are requesting a \$5.00 donation be made per agenda.

Catholic School Council Elections

Elections for School Council for the 2010-2011 school year will be scheduled shortly. A nomination ballot has been sent home and elections will follow if necessary. The School Council meets a minimum of four times throughout the year and supports the school in promoting student achievement. We hope many parents will allow their names to stand for election, as it is an excellent forum to communicate your ideas and concerns.
