FOCUS - In Mathematics, students will focus on Number Sense and Numeration (quantity, relationships, representing numbers and operations). In Reading, students will focus on making predictions,



inferences and interpreting texts (diaries, recounts, stories, poetry, biographies, memoirs, reports) and in Writing students will focus on the recount writing form.
