


attend! Eagleswings will also be on hand should parents wish to purchase or order spirit wear for their child! More information is to follow!








- We will be celebrating our Thanksgiving Mass with Father Wavne on Thursday. October 16th at 10:35 a.m. in the gym. All are welcome!
