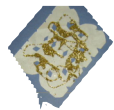

- The Gr. 7/8 students with

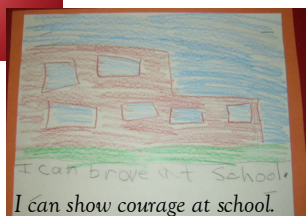
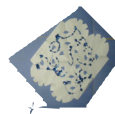
- the help of their teacher, Mrs. King are working hard fundraising for their year end school trip with hot dog lunches and movie nights.
