EQAO Grade 3 & Grade 6 Provincial Assessment Results

We are very excited to share the results of the Provincial Assessments from 2012-2013

Grade 3 Reading—Up 3% points
Grade 3 Writing—Down 5% points
Grade 3 Math—Up 5% points

Grade 6 Reading—Up 7% points
Grade 6 Writing—Down 4% points
Grade 6 Math—Up 5% points

We are thrilled that for some portions of the assessment, scores are the highest they have been in 12 years.

Though we are proud of this accomplishment, we are determined to continue to see this upward trend in student achievement. We will be focusing strongly on mathematics this year and look forward to having loads of fun in the process!

We will be celebrating Mass on Thursday, October 10th in honour of Thanksgiving.

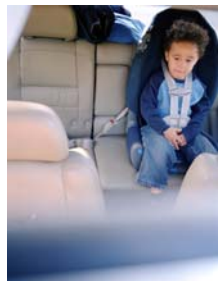
We have also be treating the students to a Turkey lunch after mass again this year. This meal is open only to students.
