Topic 1: Artificial Intelligence – NCDSB Guiding Principles and Starting Points

Entity Hosting: Virtual Webinar

Presenter(s)/Facilitator(s): Facilitated by the Director of Education

Description: All staff will engage in an introductory learning session to understand the NCDSB approach to the integration of AI in learning, teaching, and working responsibilities. This will include discussing AI's potential as a teaching and learning tool; how using and understanding AI is important in preparing students for success post-graduation; and how using AI should be done in a way that ensures cyber safety, cyber security, responsible use of technology, and protecting student and employee privacy. Approved board AI tools will be highlighted as part of this session.

Topic 2: Artificial Intelligence – Google AI in K-12 Education

Entity Hosting: Self-directed learning modules

Presenter(s)/Facilitator(s): Self-directed learning modules

Description: All staff will engage in self-directed learning modules that addresses the use of Google AI tools to support teaching and learning activities. Based on their current level of experience with AI, staff will select to focus their learning on one of the following topics: 1) Generative AI - exploring how to use generative AI tools to assist their teaching practice by saving time on everyday tasks, personalizing instruction to meet student needs, and enhancing lessons and activities in creative ways; or 2) Google AI – discovering ways to use Gemini with a variety of Google Workspace for Education apps, like Docs, Gmail, and Slides to boost productivity and enhance teaching practices.
