

Rural and Northern Education Funding

As part of its plan to strengthen rural and northern education, the Ministry of Education announced on June 28, 2017 (Memo 2017: B09) a Rural and Northern Education supplement of \$20 million as an enhancement to the Grants for Student Needs (GSN). The funding allows school boards to further improve education for students in rural communities.

For 2023-2024, The Northeastern Catholic District School received an in-year allocation of \$ 178,739.

A total of \$475,136 was brought forward from prior years' unspent allocation.

The total allocation available for the 23-24 school year was \$653,875.

Of the total allocation of \$653,875 available for the 2023-2024 school year, \$97,524 was spent, deferring \$556,351 to the 2024-25 school year.
