Sister Helen Leeney, also known as Sister Margaret Helen passed away on May 27th, 2011 in the 73rd year of her Religious Life. Sister Margaret Helen served as the founding principal of O'Gorman High School from 1953 to 1965. As a member of the Grey Sisters of the Immaculate Conception, she served her Catholic Community in many ways; with her teaching career spanning 40 years.

Sister Margaret Helen's dedication and commitment to Catholic Education were prevalent during her term as O'Gorman's principal. She was very supportive to all students and she made a difference in the lives of many students.

Colleen Landers, a past student of Sister Margaret Helen, a proud O'Gorman High School alumnus and current NCDSB Board Trustee, commented "She always had a close tie with Timmins and O'Gorman High School and she came back for all the reunions as she felt that she was a member of the O'Gorman family.
