POLICY STATEMENT

The first responsibility of the Board is to ensure quality education. Further, it's not the Board's intention to discourage groups, agencies and/or various associations from pursuing their objectives.

While the Board reserves the right to authorize distribution of material to its student population, it is required that various organizations, groups and agencies obtain written authorization from the Director of Education prior to the distribution and/or posting of any material in the various work places within the jurisdiction of the Board.

POLICY REGULATIONS

This policy applies to all requests from various individuals, community groups, municipal/provincial/federal government agencies and commercial enterprises.

1. The Board, as a responsible community partner, supports the efforts of schools in facilitating communication between community groups, government agencies and appropriate commercial enterprises and to its school community.
2. The Board recognizes that, in approving displays, posters, advertising and announcements, and where communication to parents is distributed via students, it has a responsibility to protect students from the influence of inappropriate levels of commercial and/or political advertising.
3. Advertising and materials displayed or distributed throughout the system will reflect the best interests of the students and staff under the Board's jurisdiction and the school community at large.
4. The Board reserves the right to approve or deny approval for the posting, display and/or distribution of any advertising, announcement, information, literature, or materials as it may deem appropriate.
