RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Mathematics Facilitator will help to oversee the preparation for the revised math curriculum implementation and provide training and professional development to Teachers on implementing high impact instructional strategies in mathematics including large-group learning sessions, school-based learning sessions and/or side-by-side coaching opportunities. The Math Facilitator will work collaboratively with school and system leaders and will support the implementation and monitoring of the board improvement plan to improve mathematics The Mathematics Facilitator will work collaboratively with all performance. stakeholders, working to bring actions to life to enhance student achievement, instructional practice and system partnerships in the area of mathematics. The Mathematics Facilitator will work in conjunction with the Superintendent of Education to develop and implement any required action plans related to Mathematics. Other duties may also be assigned at the discretion of a Superintendent of Education.

This termed position is funded by the Ministry of Education as part of the Math Strategy.

- Mathematics Specialist or minimum of Part II with a commitment to complete specialist by January 2021;
- 5 years teaching experience at the elementary panel; and
