Topic 1: Literacy Instruction Kindergarten to Grade 4

Entity Hosting: Schools

Description: Kindergarten to Grade 4 English and French Immersion staff will engage in an initial learning session related to the new Core Phonics program adopted by the board for September 2025. This session will focus on the scope and sequence of lessons, lesson structure, sound wall and progress monitoring.
