The Superintendents of Education presented enrolment information by school and shared some highlights about programs and opportunities being afforded to our students across our district. They were very pleased to share that our current enrolment numbers are slightly higher than projected in the Budget Estimates. We have seen an increase of 46 full time equivalent (FTE) at elementary and 16.5 FTE at secondary.

Director Tricia Stefanic Weltz shared her professional growth goals as per Policy *T-9 Director of Education Performance Appraisal*. This included enhancing the profile of the NCDSB, improving student achievement, strengthening organizational culture and effectiveness, and refining communication strategies to secure accountability.
