A series of reports were presented to the Board of Trustees. This included information regarding the 2025-26 Special Education Board Plan, technology procurements and a tender report for work to be completed at two elementary schools.



Student Trustees’ Report

School activities highlighted included the Grad Retreat, Heads Up!, OHS Career Fair, Day in the Parking Lot, Indigenous History Month, and Planet Youth. Classroom highlights included Mrs. Charlebois’ Hospitality and Tourism course and Mme Stewart’s Géographie class. Extracurricular coverage featured soccer, track and field, and LINK bowling—highlighted by Aaron Kleinhuis’ bronze medal finish at OFSAA. The student trustees also shared insights from their learning experiences while attending the Ontario Student Trustees’ Association (OSTA) conference in May.



2025-2026 NCDSB Budget Estimates

Superintendent of Business Keld Scott presented the 2025-2026 Budget Estimates to the Board of Trustees. The balanced budget of \$52,794,495.00 was unanimously passed by the Board of Trustees.

MYSP Year End Celebration

The Director of Education shared the final accountability report highlighting the progress made by each department towards their goal, linked to the Multi-Year Strategic Plan. There was a range of goals addressing different pillars of the MYSP. In summary, it was noted that every department made progress towards the achievement of the goals, there was shared ownership of the actions taken throughout the year, we experienced improved accountability measures to monitor progress, and there is a greater sense of community in working together.
