It has been five years since the <u>Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014</u> (CCEYA) came into effect on August 31, 2015. It was designed to strengthen compliance, health and safety in child care settings across the province. As part of the Act, the Ministry of Education is required to conduct a review of the legislation within five years of it coming into effect.

The Ministry of Education wants to hear about how the early years and child care system is meeting the needs and expectations of parents, guardians and child care stakeholders.

This information will support the review of the CCEYA and help improve the system to better meet the needs of families. These surveys are open until July 21, 2020.
