Art

Make a Butterfly. Use markers to draw a variety of lines and shapes on a kleenex, paper towel or coffee filter. Fasten in the middle with a clothespin, twist tie or elastic.

As a family, take turns acting out nursery rhymes (e.g. hickory dicory doc, itsy bitsy spider, twinkle twinkle little star) while the others guess (like charades).

Make a set of binoculars using two toilet paper rolls. Decorate and add a string to hang them around your neck. Peek out a window or go outside and see what you can find.
