

COMMUNITY MEMBERS SOUGHT FOR AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Northeastern Catholic District School Board is currently inviting applications for one volunteer community member to serve on its Audit Committee.

We are seeking a community member with accounting and financial expertise and business knowledge to serve for a three-year term effective immediately.

The Audit Committee is comprised of the Chair of the Board, two additional trustees and two independent members drawn from the community at large.

The primary role of the Audit Committee is to assist the Board of Trustees in fulfilling its duties related to governance and oversight. The duties of the Audit Committee fall under the following key areas:

- i) the financial reporting process;
- ii) internal control framework;
- iii) risk management practices;
- iv) performance and function of the Board's internal and external auditors;
- v) the Board's compliance with its obligations under legislation.

The Audit Committee meets at least three times per year. Members will receive training and access to professional learning modules to clarify roles and responsibilities.

Candidate Eligibility:

- Sufficient accounting, senior financial management or legal expertise to understand public sector accounting and auditing standards.
- Applicant cannot be a current employee or officer of the Board or of any other district school board or school authority.
- Applicant cannot not have a parent, child or spouse currently employed by the NCDSB.
