St. Joseph School Emergency Closure March 4, 2021

The Northeastern Catholic District School Board is notifying the public, parents/guardians of an Emergency School Closure for St. Joseph School beginning today, Thursday, March 4 at 1:00pm and extending to Friday, March 5, 2021. At this time, it is the expectation that in-class learning will resume on Monday, March 8, 2021.

St. Joseph School will be closed to students and staff on Friday, March 5, 2021.

This emergency closure is due to a plumbing and sewer issue that cannot be rectified immediately. Staff is in the process of contacting parents/guardians to pick up their children as soon as possible. Any students remaining at school at the end of today will be dismissed as per usual (taking the bus, walking.)

Staff is also working diligently to prepare students for Remote Learning (*learning from home*) for Friday, March 5, 2021. Students should arrive home today with their technology.

We will keep families posted with more information as it becomes available.
