POLICY STATEMENT

Trustees of the Northeastern Catholic District School Board (NCDSB) occupy positions of public trust and confidence. Trustees are an integral part to governance in a Catholic school system, and serve students and communities across the broad geographic jurisdiction of the Board. In the event that a position becomes vacant for any reason before the expiration of the term for which the Trustee was elected, the NCDSB shall endeavour to appoint a qualified replacement as soon as possible and in accordance with the *Education Act*, to ensure the scope of responsibilities are executed by a complete Board of Trustees.

POLICY REGULATIONS

- 1.0 A Trustee vacancy shall be addressed in a manner consistent with the *Education Act*.
- 2.0 The Secretary of the Board shall report the cause of a vacancy at the first Public meeting of the Board after the cause is known. Subsequently, the remaining Trustees shall pass a resolution declaring the office vacant effective on the date of the meeting, or on the date provided for by the *Education Act*.
- 3.0 Administrative procedures shall outline specific details and requirements of filling a vacant office of trustee in accordance with the *Education Act* and the Procedural By-Law of the Board of Trustees.
