FAMILY DAY



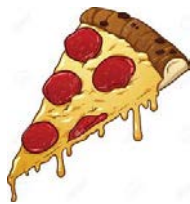
Just a friendly reminder that **Monday, February 17** is Family Day. Enjoy the long weekend with your family!
