Once again this year we are offering students and their families and opportunity to purchase school clothing called, "**Spirit Wear**".


These items are heat-pressed so are more affordable. The great thing about the "Spirit Wear" is that students and their parents can **design their own shirts**!


You may purchase (t-shirt [\$16], long-sleeve t-shirt [\$22] or pouch hoodie [\$35] or a special deal of a hoodie and t-shirt [\$45]), then students may choose **4 - 7 designs** to have on their shirts, **at least one of which must be a school logo option**. To promote school pride, clothing will be available in white or grey only.

The process:

Once you decide to make a purchase, you will need to do the following things:

- 1. Look at the logos that are available to you (back of page)
- 2. Decide which logos that you would like to have on your shirt (see sample for #)
- 3. Mark on the template(s) where you would like the logos placed (e.g. right sleeve, left chest, across the back at the bottom, on the pouch ...)
- 4. Return the order to the school with payment (cheques should be made payable to English Catholic School) by **Wednesday November 9th.**
- 5. Once orders are returned to the school, Charlene, from Eagle Wings Embroidery, will come to the school (tentative date: Wednesday November 9th -11 3:30 p.m) to find the right size of shirt for each student who placed an order and verify the logos and the placement. Parents are welcome to come and meet with Charlene
- 6. Finished shirts will be ready in time for Christmas.




